HERE ARE SOME OF THE INITIATIVES OF HOTEL LOS YAMANAS :

- 1. Implement energy saving practices:** Use energy-efficient lamps, install motion sensors in common areas to control lighting, and promote responsible energy use in rooms.
- 2. Encourage the use of renewable energy:** We installed solar panels to generate electricity and light up our park.
- 3. Promote efficiency in water consumption:** We installed water saving devices in taps, showers and toilets.
- 4. Implement recycling policies:** Place recycling bins in common areas and rooms, and educate guests on the importance of recycling.
